Electrical safety is part and parcel of prudent home ownership, but all too often when people move house it is something that gets forgotten. If you are moving into an older style property, the original wiring could still be there and might not be able to cope with modern appliances. If any problems do come to light, ask for a quote to find out what needs to be done, and how much it will cost, to put right. Always get a quote before agreeing to any remedial work being carried out.

During a safety check all aspects of your system will be thoroughly examined. This will give you peace of mind, as you can be sure that every component has been correctly installed and is operating properly. If any potential hazards are found, then a remedial course of action can be suggested, and implemented with your approval.

If you are thinking of tackling electrical jobs yourself, be fully aware of any, and all, risks that you may face. Don't forget that electricity can prove fatal if not handled properly. Faulty wiring and installations are the leading cause of domestic fires, with in excess of 67,000 fires caused by these problems each year.

An electrical fire is extremely difficult to detect, and potentially catastrophic. The main problems lie in the fact that they produce neither smell nor smoke, and can smoulder for up to a year before catching alight igniting surrounding material. It is not until that the other combustible material produces smoke that your smoke detectors will sound.

So whatever work you have decided to carry out, only attempt what you are capable of, if in doubt get a professional electrician in. Never work on a live circuit, always make sure that you have tripped the appropriate breaker at the circuit board. It might sound like common sense, but it is surprising the amount of people who actually forget to do this simple safety step.

There are safety devices available on the market, such as GFCI outlets and AFCIs. A GFCI will plug into an outlet socket and should a ground fault occur, it will trip, preventing any power getting to the appliance. An AFCI is slightly different in that it is installed in the wiring, and will trip if there is an arc fault.

A common fault is that power continuously gets interrupted to part of the house. This would be mainly noticeable if a breaker is constantly tripping, or a fuse is often blowing. Think if anything new has been installed in that part of the house, maybe that is causing a greater demand than the circuit is gauged for. Maybe moving the appliance to a different circuit would alleviate the problem. As with all things, dealing with electricity, if unsure consult a qualified Los Altos electrical team.
