Trucks are more than just vehicles designed with large bins and tires. They are usually identified according to their function, which their structural design depends on. Take delivery trucks for example: various industries involving delivery of materials in large quantity use different types of delivery trucks such as freightliners, mail trucks, refrigerator trucks, tank trucks, and wide loads.

Freightliners

This type of delivery truck is considered a semi-truck a type of heavy duty truck that can carry all types of cargo. As a matter of fact, the term freightliner originated from the name of a manufacturer of heavy duty trucks. Freightliners can be medium to heavy-duty delivery trucks that are often seen on highways.

Mail Trucks

As the name suggests, mail trucks are intended for mail delivery by federal post offices as well as corporate mail delivery companies. These trucks are usually smaller than other delivery trucks because they are intended to be used in travelling through small neighborhoods. What makes mail trucks different from the other types of delivery trucks is that they are designed with steering wheels and pedals on the right to enable the driver in accessing the mailboxes located on the right side of the road.

Refrigerator Trucks

For companies that deliver products that need to be kept cold, refrigerator trucks are the best option. This type of truck is primarily intended for carrying frozen items such as meat, fish, ice tubes, and ice cream. Take note that the cab areas of refrigerator trucks such as Isuzu NPR Ontario dealers have to offer are not really cold. Only the cargo areas of these trucks are treated with carbon dioxide, an effective cooling agent.

Tank Trucks

Another member of the family of semi trucks is tank truck, a delivery truck used for transporting hazardous materials. Light-duty tank trucks can hold up to 1000 gallons of liquid, while medium duty trucks such as Isuzu NQR Ontario dealers have to offer can hold up to 4000 gallons. Heavy duty tank trucks can even transport up to 9000 gallons and can have either insulated or non-insulated cargo areas.

Wide Loads

Wide loads such as Isuzu NRR Ontario dealers have to offer can be easily identified by flashing lights and yellow signage as indicators when traveling through major highways. This type of heavy-duty truck is designed with flat beds for carrying heavier cargos such as construction elements, prebuilt homes, and others. Keep in mind that trucks with flatbeds usually require special permits and extra vehicles to drive in their front and back ends, since their size makes them prone to hitting other things on the road.
