Despite the advancements in technology and know-how with regard to addressing the case of infertility, sometimes, if a baby's not for you, you really can't blame the fertility clinic for not trying to help. The moment you step into any fertility assistance facility, the initial and underlying guarantee is that the institution and its staff will do everything possible to help you conceive a child. However, in rare cases where despite efforts conception does not happen, fertility clinics offer a refund program or a money-back system.

## What Qualifies For A Refund?

In most cases, money-back programs offered by a fertility clinic take effect when after a specific period of trying to help a couple conceive a successful live birth does not happen. In others, the guarantee applies even as early as the failure to conceive. Take note of the return policy of the fertility clinic you are eyeing to find out how it conducts its satisfaction guarantee process, if at all. This is why before you decide on signing up with a fertility clinic, read the fine print and know whether or not it offers this service.

Ideally, a fertility clinic should offer a guarantee since the service it is offering leads toward a successful conception and live birth. This may be transcended in very rare situations, of course, when all efforts have been implemented and still nothing happens. Discuss this part with your chosen medical provider or institution before you sign up.

## What Does A Refund Mean?

All patients should qualify for a refund in case the initiatives toward achieving a live birth do not succeed. In the case of a fertility clinic, a refund means the return of all costs or a significant percentage of the total cost allocated for the initiative, covering the tests, treatments, use of donor eggs and other services and items you may have purchased along the way. Of course, a refund happens within a pre-specified time, so make sure you know these ranges.

A refund in a fertility clinic also often means you have to be under a certain age to qualify. If you're above 39 years old, for instance, which means your chances of conceiving are very low from the start, some fertility clinics do not offer this refund or offer only 50 per cent of your total expenses. In some fertility clinics, this could be higher or lower.

In the end, you must understand that while a fertility clinic is functioning to help you have a baby, there are certain circumstances such as your age, body type, actual health status and other unforeseen situations that might greatly affect your ability to conceive and give birth. Your medical provider should be upfront with you about it from the very beginning and you must fully understand how much of a money back guarantee you can obtain out of your attempt. A fertility clinic is designed to help you have a baby and will more likely do everything it can to make it happen.
