After which, it should be put in a sealed plastic bag to ensure that no bed bugs can get inside such attire.

The management of hotels and apartments should be committed in the prevention and control of these uninvited guests. This is because one cannot fully eradicate these bed bugs immediately. This takes time since complex processes are involved. This also needs dedication and effort on the part of the hotel and apartment management and staff.
