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This article is all about BPO services, or “Business Process Outsourcing.” This is one type or subset of basic outsourcing (such as offshore outsourcing or logistics outsourcing, data entry or telemarketing). It involves the contracting of specific business processes or functions to a third-party service provider. This set up frees up the main company to expand into new areas because there’s less to do on a daily basis that would take up a lot of time and energy if it were all done by that main company. You’re simply replacing in-house employees and labor to alternative out of house employees.

People may categorize BPO into something called back office outsourcing. This includes internal areas of businesses such as human resources or finance and accounting offices. Front-office outsourcing, on the other hand, intuitively completes the picture, referring to customer-services and reception for customers.

BPO may be done outside the company’s country, and in that case, it is referred to as a version of offshore outsourcing. If the country is nearby but still not a part of the same country as the company, it’s logically called “nearshore outsourcing.” Many of the services that BPO will handle are informational or technologically based, so they are somewhat bland and can be done by a wide variety of people. This makes outsourcing easier, because you don’t need to have intensive trainings for your new outsourced employees and you don’t need to worry that the job may be done incorrectly.

BPO is mostly used to increase a company’s ability to be flexible in various situations. It can mostly be organizationally flexible, because you can delegate responsibilities to different areas of employees rather than keeping everything in-house. The speed of business processing is greatly increased as well. This obviously is helpful for lots of reasons. This allows the business to focus on its “core competencies,” such as product development and different ways to train employees to better perform their jobs. When the company can focus on themselves rather than on administrative duties, they’ll be able to thrive better.
