Tire Pressure Checks

Under inflated tires can increase fuel consumption by up to 3 percent. One study estimates that 50-80 percent of the tires traveling on Canadian roadways are under inflated. Surprisingly, commercial trucks and semi trailer owners could save up to 2 billion gallons of fuel each year by properly inflating their tires.

Let the Air Flow

Dirty air filters can increase fuel consumption by as much as 15 percent. Air filters keep impurities from damaging the interior of the engine, so replacing dirty filters will save diesel and protect your engine. Check the air filter at every oil change or once a week if you are working in a dusty environment.
