Storage tank is something, which is used to hold or store liquids or compressed gas. Artificial lakes or ponds can be termed as storage tanks as well. These can also be called artificial containers. Some storage tanks are there that needs additional floating roofs. The roof is used to maintain a balancing act since the liquid inside rises and falls during transportation. It is also beneficial to maintain the total vapor space present above the level of the liquid. It is also considered as a measure to prevent pollution and ensure safety. Different types of storage tanks include DISPATCH, COT, PIT, UTILITIES, OSBL, and ISBL.
