Obviously a restaurant is bound to have an accumulation of waste after each day passes. While some of the garbage is organic material such as fruits, vegetables, bread, and animal bones, other garbage consists of paper, metal cans, plastic containers, foil, and other materials that normally go to the landfill. Plastic alone takes up 40% of the space at a landfill. There is a movement towards recycling and businesses such as restaurants are getting on board. Some of them are using the recycling systems of the city in which the restaurant is located. Yet, many cities do not provide recycling programs and it is necessary for the restaurant to do this all on their own. At the end of a busy work day it is much easier to throw the waste in the garbage and have it taken to the dump than it is to use recycling equipment. Sometimes businesses do not have enough money for recycling equipment or conveyor systems. They may not even have enough money for knife sharpening services. Some restaurants need to decide between buying recycling equipment like conveyor systems and utilizing knife sharpening services. There are a few lucky restaurants that do have enough funds for recycling equipment like conveyor systems as well as knife sharpening services.

The way it works is they use the equipment to separate their garbage and ensure that all recyclables are removed. A magnetic separator may be used which is a magnet that attaches to all metal and separates it from the rest of the garbage. There are other devices that help make sorting the trash easier as well. Some business owners have good intentions and they would like to recycle they just don't know how. They may assume that if their city or community does not provide a program for reuse and recycle that there are no other options. They may not even realize that they themselves can start their own program. They can even team up with other businesses in the area and take turns taking the items to a recycle center. They can also put funds together as a group and share the recycling equipment like the conveyor systems. Perhaps one business can invest in the equipment for reusing materials in the other can invest in knife sharpening equipment. The two facilities can share and this way they each have exactly what they need for both recycling and knife sharpening. Another type of product that they can invest in is a granulator. The way that this device works is that plastic is broken down into very tiny pieces that can be resolving it as raw materials.
