Monitors

The vehicles fitted with GPS tracking devices are only limited to the devices the firm is making use of. Typically the systems are commonly used on vans and commercial trucks. However, there are no GPS trackers for trailers but development is underway. New models have onboard diagnostics to make work easier. Basically, diagnostic is the interface between the equipment fitted on your vehicle and a computer aided program easily accessible at the headquarters.

Capabilities

GPS tracking devices can track your vehicle using several characteristics as mentioned below: Speed – This is determined by the automobile’s speedometer. It simply reports the speed of the car at a given time. That way the company is notified when a driver exceeds the agreed speed limit as well as the time the automobile is not running.

Idle time and Route - In companies that offer delivery services to businesses and customers alike, the idle time at the drop-off or pick up destination is of utmost importance. GPS tracking devices can effectively monitor the exact time the automobile is not moving. Using the device, the route the employees use is recorded with pin-point accuracy. The firm can see how fast the driver moves and the exact time the vehicle is making the deliveries.

Fuel- fuel consumption is recorded as well. This is important so that in the event a problem occurs the company is notified immediately. For instance when the truck is always low in fuel the driver is held accountable. In most cases, the company can check for fuel system anomaly hitches, improper driver conduct or tire inflation.

Besides fleet management, GPS trackers have an array of uses as well. Today, there are child tracking systems to help you locate your children within seconds. A mobile tracker is attached to the child and data is transmitted to your browser on demand, allowing you to track their every move. On the other hand, travelers can use GPS devices in location tagging or when looking for directions, as well as routine activities like hotel reservations and flight booking.

GPS trackers have enormous usage and they are commonly used in military systems, aircraft, shipping, automobiles and farm vehicles. In most cases, they are fitted by car manufactures to give car owners peace of mind when the vehicle is stolen. In the event this happens the tracker automatically pinpoints its location.
