Document scanning involves a principle quite similar with that in modern photography where light is used to electronically record an image. The object containing the image, usually a printout document, is placed on the glass plate with the image facing downward to the scanner. The light that passes through the glass plate allows the charge-couple device (CCD), the core component of the scanner, to capture and make an electronic copy of the image.

A company benefits in document scanning in a number of ways. The three most common advantages are ease of retrieval, exchange, and space efficiency. Electronic files are easier to retrieve and exchange between distant offices if made available in a single server.

Setting aside a room for document storage is a major concern of every company.
