Hitch Pin Locks

While it may seem trivial, the theft of ball mounts is very common. They are usually very easy to remove, and once taken, can offer a quick turnaround financially for the thief. A hitch pin lock ensures that your ball mount is attached to your tow bar in a way that prevents a simple "single bolt" removal of the mount itself. This is a great deterrent for ball mount theft.

Dual Trailer Locks

If you're like many travelers, you like to bring your boat or jet skis to the lake for a weekend away. However, they are quite vulnerable when left on the trailer unsupervised. Dual trailer locks prevent the removal of the nut directly below the towbar, which makes the removal of the trailer next to impossible. Another added perk to this safety accessory: insurance companies love it!

"Couple-Mate"

This device is something that serves a couple of purposes for your trailer. Initially, it's designed to ensure that your trailer hitch lines up over the ball mount every time without strenuous guidance or effort. However, it falls into our safety conversation because it also secures the trailer to the vehicle, preventing an easy "grab" for any passerby that finds your trailer enticing.

Safety on the road is one thing, but when you are considering the thefts that occur every year on highways across the globe, there is no doubt that security of your towing trailers is an important contingency to keep in mind.
