Always go for larger cover than a tight-fitting one. Ensure correct measurement of the bumpers and tiers. While checking the height of fifth wheel cover, better measure it with the air conditioner and without it..

One more thing that you need to be wary about while using the fifth wheel cover is the manner in which you cover the roof. Climbing on top of the roof is not recommended and the best way to do it will be to make use of a stepladder. Just make sure that the antennas, mirrors; AC units are not poking out, as this may lead to wear and tear of the fifth wheel cover. Covering up the RV in a proper manner adds more years to it. By spending just 10 minutes covering the vehicle with fifth wheel cover you do ensure longevity of the vehicle.

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
