The infant's scalp and face may also swell, which is only temporary for some, but become too serious for others that surgery may be needed.

Erb's Palsy

It is also possible to stretch the nerves around the baby's shoulder during the birthing processes due to excessive pulling out. As a result, Erb's Palsy, or brachial plexus injury, occurs. If facial paralysis results from inappropriate use of surgical tools, this can be blamed on inefficient surgical techniques.
