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If you happen to be one of those unfortunate souls who paid for a product and got injured by it, then this article is meant especially for you. Where a person gets injured on account of faulty products, it entitles him to make Product Liability Claims. The range of faulty or defective products may be broad, yet the claims generally fall into three distinct categories- defective design, failure to provide instructions or warnings and defective manufacture. Let us now proceed to discuss these three types of product liability claims.

Understanding these broad divisions will actually help you determine whether your claim is valid or not. Let us begin from injury compensation claims arising out of defectively manufactured products. For faulty and defective items, the good part is, each and every state appears to have the same laws. However, it needs to be borne in mind that for each of these compensation claims, you should not only show that the item was indeed faulty, but that the defect also gave you an injury. Claims involving defectively produced or manufactured products are probably the most common of all product liability claims. Now these items are flawed to the core since their manufacturing process itself was faulty. The problem here can be traced back to the production facility manufacturing it. As a result, these injury causing items are different from their well produced counterparts adorning shop windows.

While defective design and defective manufacture may appear to denote the same thing at the outset, they are, in fact, distinct entities. In case of defective product design, as the name clearly suggests, the whole thing has been designed in such a way that makes it potentially dangerous for users. For injuries resulting out of such defective designs, the user can make Injury Compensation Claims.

The third category of product liability compensation claim involves failure on part of the manufacturer to provide warnings and instructions about the item's right usage. These failures can lead to injuries when the product in question is a highly dangerous one.

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
