Scanning

Once the document has been thoroughly prepared for the scanning, the actual process begins with state-of-the-art scanning software employed for high quality scanning. When scanned, the paper document is transformed into an image. Then the image is modified in order to get the best representation of the paper document. Scanning can be done in color, or black and white.

Indexing and Formatting

Once scanned, the image will be entered into a document management system. The scanned file then needs to be transferred to the required format and for that the file is indexed. With advanced software, all areas of the image are captured. Text and character recognition tools enable minute areas of the image to be captured. Letters and numbers are identified through text recognition and character recognition tools.

Sending

The image is then made a file and formatted to the required extension. Then, the files are checked

for quality in order to ensure the best possible result. The files are then sent back to the client through a storage device such as a pen drive, CD or DVD, or even uploaded directly to the FTP server of the document scanning company.

These document scanning services may be extensive, but are certainly cost-effective and adaptable to individual client needs. There is no project document scanning solutions can't cater to, be it a large scale and long term project or a small scale need-based one.
