Tips for curvy girls

For this reason, look for women's coats that are tailored to nip in at the waist, or that come with a belt you can tie to emphasise your curves. You might also like to look for coats that have slightly padded shoulders so that your curves are balanced out.

However, if you have broad shoulders, you are generally advised to avoid shoulder pads and instead go for women's coats that have deeper armholes and v-necks. This helps to create more balance in your figure. V-neck coats are also a good option for women who have larger busts, as if the neck of your coat comes up too high, it will make you look top heavy. Instead, opt for single breasted coats that taper down to your waist.

Tips for athletic figures

For women with more athletic figures, when it comes to choosing your perfect coat, it is often a good idea to go for "princess-shaped" coats, as these will add more shape to your body. Seamed bodices are also a good option for giving yourself more shape and, if you have got a small bust, it's a good idea to look for coats that have details on the upper half that give the illusion of shape. For example, pockets and wide lapels are good options, and if you go for a coat that pulls in at the waist, this will make the most of your curves.

If you are someone who is both short and slim, then like women who are petite, you should avoid overly long coats and instead go for something shorter so you can make the most of the length of your legs.
