Choosing the right and the best cell phone plans can be a huge and difficult task. The smartest way to choose the best cell plan, or a wireless plan, evaluate, and determine how you first use your wireless phone.

Trying to compare the best phone plans, it is important to save money and get the best wireless phone service.

Time is an important issue that you should consider when you compare the best wireless plans as time of day to determine the cost per call, if you choose a basic plan.

Do you make your phone calls a day? Identify what and where you are calling - local, national, family or emergency use only. Unlimited Sprint Mobile to Mobile calls you make or receive unlimited calls directly to or from Sprint PCS and Nextel subscribers, and the Nationwide Sprint PCS Network without the use of your service plan minutes.

If you mainly use your cell phone in the evenings and weekends, to choose the best plan that offers free nights and weekends. Keep in mind that the exact start and end time of the peak and off-peak minutes varies from one provider to another. Make sure you know how long nights and weekends start, because they differ from wireless phone carriers.

Do you need a phone for personal or business purposes? If you plan to use the phone for personal use only, you may not need a mobile wireless plan with many, but not for business purposes, where you are looking for the best cell phone plan with unlimited minutes of usage minutes.

For those that rarely use my cell phone and would like to emergencies, then prepaid cell phone option, and maybe a cheaper solution than the monthly mobile phone bill. With pre-paid mobile phones are no contracts to sign, no monthly bills, no long-term commitments, no credit checks, no age limits and no hidden charges.

When choosing the best mobile plans with various cellular carriers, you should consider the following factors:

Local calling area - a geographical area or a place that cellular phone customer can call without incurring toll charges for mobile phones.

Regional Plans - Regional plans may be cheaper, but they will cost you if you use your cell phone outside of your regional network. Regional network of call is generally more mobile phone call to your local calling area of a mobile phone area.

National plans - the national plan will allow you to use your mobile phone across the country without roaming charges.

Roaming charges - If you are using your phone outside your local calling area home, you are said to be roaming and roaming charges will apply.
