It explores the new world, and offers an elegant way to access and share data using the latest of the web technologies such as Gecko (layout engine that reads web content, such as HTML, CSS, XUL, and JavaScript and renders it on a user's screen), Necko-a network library that provides a platform-independent API for several layers of networking, ranging from transport to presentation layers, NSPR which provides a platform-neutral API for system level and libc-like functions, NSS i.e. Network Security Services (NSS) a set of libraries designed to support cross-platform development of security-enabled client and server applications, and more. Recently Firefox has added Twitter as a search option in Firefox for Windows, Mac and Linux, which will make it easier to discover new topics, the search is currently available in English, Portuguese, Slovenian and Japanese versions of Firefox, with more languages to come in future releases. In the new version 8.0.1 it has fixed previous issues related to the crashing of Mac OS X and Windows startup crash caused by RoboForm versions older than 7.6.2.

Despite all, issues pertaining to the installation, update and upgrade are common. There can be compatibility issues with the Google Toolbar, Add-ons and more. Post-installation problems related to the pop-up, unwanted add-on installation, accessibility of the Internet, e-mail and web-based applications can baffle you a lot. Stability and security issues may also crop up. Firefox crashes

Though Firefox automatically updates itself but you can check it manually and it can fix the crashing issues. You can configure for the "automatic update" to let thing run in the background. You must update your plugins, Windows, drivers and Internet Security software. Perform a security scan to check for viruses or spyware. If you are not reaching the crux and experiencing the problem even in Safe-Mode then seek online Support for Mozilla Firefox.

Error loading web sites

Try to understand the cause behind. If the problem only happens with certain websites then possibly the Firefox's cookies and cache are responsible and it will be displayed as: "The connection was interrupted", "The connection was reset", "The connection has timed out". Immediately clear the "Firefox History".

However, if your website loads but doesn't work properly or look right, images or animations do not show or video or audio does not play or Firefox never finishes loading certain websites, and you are getting errors like: "Secure Connection Failed", "Error code 500 accessing secure sites" or "initialize the browser security component". Check your web-address starts if it starts with https:// (notice the "s") then check SSL settings, proxy settings and security software. However, if it happens with other sites then turn off hardware acceleration and update or disable all extensions.

The Adobe Flash plugin has crashed

The error message shows when Flash plugin stops working unexpectedly. You need to uninstall the outdated Flash Plugin and replace it with the latest version.
