•Fifth day of the Orissa tour, visiting Chatikona and Jeypore to meet Dhongaria Kondh, Desia Kondh and Mali tribe people.

•Sixth day, the party moves to Onukudeli and Lamptaput visiting the colorful tribes of Gadabas and Didayee

•Seventh day, proceeding to Kunduli and Nandapur to witness the biggest weekly market of Sana Paroja and also the Pottery making place at Jeypore

•Eighth day, proceeding to Gupteswar to visit the tribal market of Dhuruba tribes and cave temple of Lord Shiva

•Ninth day, drive to Laxmipur and Rayagada, visiting Jagannath Temple there and the Tribal Museum at Koraput

•Tenth day, to Taptapani and Gopalpur, visiting Chandragiri Tibettan Settlement and Taptapani Hot Sulper Spring water

•Eleventh day, as much as 200 km drive to Chilika Lake the largest Brakish Water Lake in Asia, passing through Birnarsingpur a typical Orissa village and reaching Puri for the overnight stay

•Twelfth day, visit to Puri Jagannath Temple and Konark Sun Temple and on

•Thirteenth day, visiting a few ancient temples at Bhubaneswar and taking the return flight or train, after the members complete their Orissa tour.
