If you bought your remote control helicopters from the same store where you intend to have your toy fixed, it is most likely that they will not charge a single centavo for this service. Normally, if you have purchased the toy in the last 12 months, it is still covered by what we call as the "warranty."

You can avail of this warranty if your toy helicopter was damaged. Of course, this service is only applicable to the store or shop where you bought it from. The store will fix the damage at no cost. So bring the warranty form or receipt that came with the toy when you bought it. This will prove that you purchased the toy from that store.

But if you cannot go back to the toy stop where you got it from, you can also visit any toy shops that sell remote control helicopters for some technical help. If you do this, expect that they will charge you for this service. Most of toy shops offer this kind of service for a fee. But you don't have to worry about it because this fee is set at a very minimum amount only.

If you purchased your toy helicopter from an online store, which a lot of people did, you can contact that store and inquire about possible assistance or repair. It is also likely that they offer this service. Just like other toy shops, they have staff that is in charge of repairing damaged products, such as these remote control helicopters. There is no harm in trying. Who knows, they might not charge you for this service, too.

If you are just looking for some parts or accessories that were damaged, there is a high chance that you will find them from toy stores. These shops are readily available to replace damaged parts of your toy. Sometimes, you have to pay for these new parts, but you will be fortunate to find some toy stores that will replace them for free, as long as you present the warranty form or receipt.

So the moment one of your treasured remote control helicopters got damaged, look forward to getting it fixed the soonest time possible. But of course, if you can avoid crashing it, that's way better. It would be very helpful if you how to properly take care of your toy.
