Then you'll be taken to a page that allows you to select and specify the central processing unit; the heat sink and fan; the motherboard; the memory; the hard drive; the possibility for a second hard drive; the CD and DVD drive; your video card (with an option for a second video card); the operating system; software; monitor; case; power supply; networking; wireless networking for internet ease of use; sound card; speakers; floppy drive; keyboard; mouse; card reader; case fans; neon lights; thermal display; media center; IEEE1394; wiring; and warranty. If there are any questions about the different parts of the computer, simply send an email to eCollegePC and we will be able to explain to you exactly what goes into the computer and which parts will effect which processes. If you're interested in good controls for the video games you'll be playing, of course you'll want to pay attention to your keyboard and mouse. you want to make sure that more detailed games will be able to run on your computer, you'll want to ensure that you have a good video card and a good hard drive to handle all of the data.
