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Dental implants are artificial replacements for natural teeth and teeth roots. They are deemed better options to typical bridges and classic full or partial dentures. Dental implants, which do the job much like actual teeth, normally deliver a lot more security and comfort as opposed to dentures and bridges. In addition, they reinstate the ability to chew up food, enhance facial aesthetics, and enhance speech.

Dental implants are biocompatible titanium cylinders or screws that are surgically embedded onto the lower and/or upper jawbone. This renders them a firm base for artificial replacement teeth. The implants will function as the new tooth roots, hence the crown placed over them will perform exactly like natural teeth. Unlike dentures, implants are permanent and become a part of the jawbone, thus require neither adhesives nor laborious daily maintenance.

Implant surgery involves a three-step process. First, the dentist surgically installs the implant into the jaw just like an authentic tooth root. The jaw is left to heal, while the bone is allowed to grow and merge together with the implant. The recovery may last for around 3 to 6 months, in accordance with the patient's capacity to heal.

The second part consists of uncovering the first implant via one more surgery. A post is then attached to the primary implant to work as an extended part. The gum tissue is then permitted to recover for yet another three to six months so that like the bone marrow, it will wrap around the fresh post to raise its steadiness.

Once the patient has sufficiently recovered, the initial implant and the affixed post are now able to serve as foundations for the artificial replacement teeth. The dentist makes measurements and has the dental crown produced, which is tailor fit to complement all the other teeth. The crown is fastened to the post, and after several modifications by the Scottsdale cosmetic dentist, the patient will have a brand new set of teeth. The whole process can last over nine months of going to and fro to your dentist in The West's Most Western Town.

Keep in mind, however, that you will have to shell out much more money for dental implants compared to bridges or dentures. However, as any trustworthy Scottsdale dentist would tell you, implants can significantly increase your well being. Additionally, they prevent the jaw bone from weakening due to major loss of tooth.
