It is also one of the first facial parts people take notice of while they look at a face. A perfectly shaped nose enhances the beauty of a face whereas a disorganized nose provides the reverse effect. Fortunately, even the most permanent seeming features can be altered by the help of plastic surgery. Any surgical beauty treatment carried out on the nose region is known as Rhinoplasty. The cosmetic surgery for nose is also known as nose job in Sydney.

Rhinoplasty is an operation to improve the appearance of nose. The improvements can mean reduction or adding something to the existing nose to make it look better as perceived by the owner. The open and the closed techniques are the two basic approaches for a nose job. However, both techniques have their own advantages, and disadvantages.

The aesthetic nose surgery or nose job can make a difference not only in terms of the facial features but also boosts self-esteem. Major aesthetic improvements can be achieved through this plastic surgery intervention. These interventions may be accompanied by correction of anatomical defects that can cause respiratory problems, although rhinoplasty is most often used for cosmetic purposes only in Sydney.

The optimal age for boys is at least 18 years, while the ideal candidates for nose job must be over 16 for girls. This is because at this age the nasal bones reach adulthood thus making the operation possible. Given the appearance of harmony to be created between the nose and the patient's physiognomy, the patient must have realistic expectations on the outcome of the operation and it can be used to correct the appearance of the nasal pyramid.

A local anesthetic or a general anesthesia can be utilized in either of these procedures. Depending on the complexity of the work being performed, the nose surgery can be completed in two to four hours. The skin and cartilage of the nose is exposed by making use of either the internal or the external incision methods and the surgeon can then begin the artful process of sculpting and achieve the desired goals of the patient. The cosmetic plastic doctor will frequently refer to the photographs and notes he has made prior to the procedure, as rhinoplasty is really more of an art than a surgery. The symmetry of the shape of the nose is carefully checked to make sure that the changes made are the right ones. After the swelling has gone down, very small alterations and incisions can make large differences in the overall appearance.

After the sculpting process is completed by the plastic surgeon in Sydney, the blood vessels in the area are carefully checked. Whether internal or external, the incisions made during the procedure will be closed by small sutures. Finally, a small protective splint is placed around the nose. The splint will be removed after about 24 to 48 hours, on your next visit. There will be some swelling and pain. The cosmetic doctors normally prescribe antibiotics to ward off infections.
