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In recent years, a picture of safe outcome appears before us with thousands of surgeries successfully performed. No surgery is free of all risks and one should make no mistake about that. No surgery can guarantee a perfect outcome. To be sure that there are no conditions present that could make laser eye surgery unsafe for him or her the patient should consult with his primary care physician first. Like lupus or rheumatoid arthritis, such conditions range from auto-immune, to diabetes, to various infections. It is the time to do additional research if the initial examination shows laser eye surgery to be safe from an overall health aspect.

A good long record of positive outcomes the next step will be to look for an experienced ophthalmologist who has established. Aimed at thoroughly mapping the shape of the eye the doctor chosen will then conduct a series of examinations. The doctor will discuss various options for vision correction with the results of the tests in place. As they change the shape of the cornea and could affect the outcome of the surgery he will also recommend that in the few weeks before surgery no contact lenses should be worn. For several days prior to the surgery, he will also recommend that no make up or lotions be applied to the face. This recommendation by eye surgeons in Birmingham is aimed at preventing infection. Laser eye surgery is becoming popular and the surgeons are quite competent here clearly explaining any possible risks.

To think of the risks possible, it is best to have a time period between the ophthalmologist examinations and the actual surgery. To be sure there have been no troubling incidents connected to previous surgeries performed there look at the surgical center records. Schedule a meeting a few days prior to surgery to get acquainted if the surgeon is a different person from the referring ophthalmologist.

To avoid activities, such as swimming pools and contact sports, hot tubs, and strenuous activities that may injure, strain or infect the eye laser eye surgery candidates are advised. The patient is strictly restricted from rubbing or touching the eye after the eye surgery has been performed. It may result in causing an eye injury or infection due to such activities. In a few short weeks, laser eye surgery heals quickly, so an active normal life may be resumed. In the meantime, for a couple of weeks taking precautions, such as refraining from driving is usually recommended. This way laser eye surgery in Birmingham offers best possible services and help patients to regain their eyesight again.
