Strong: While most sterilization pouches in the market are made out of paper materials, this is one strong piece of paper. Since the pouches are most likely to be used to store sharp tools and pointy equipment, medical-grade paper has to withstand being torn or punctured. The edges are tightly sealed rails that increase the strength of the pouch significantly. Protection from tears and punctures means doctors and dentists do not have to worry about their tools being tainted.

Airtight: Unless doctors or dentists keep the flap in the pouches open, they have been designed to keep outside air out. Tight seals prevent the outside air from touching the tool inside, lowering the risk of the tool being contaminated by foreign bodies. Pouches also protect tools from other forms of gases, such as chemical vapor and steam. This characteristic of the pouch is essential since even the operating room or dental office can be home to bacteria.

Easy to open: Doctors and dentists need to act fast but effective in any operation, especially if it is a dire emergency. Sterilization pouches have been designed to open and close easily for the doctor or dentist to grab the tool he needs at the most critical time. In any operation, the doctor or dentist will have no time to spend the rest of the day trying to open a pouch that does not even budge.

Other uses: The field of medicine is not the only one that can use sterilization pouches but also non-medical personnel like tattoo artists. As long as something not related to medicine uses a myriad of blades and needles for aesthetic purposes, pouches are a must have. Even the tattoo artist knows he must keep his needles clean so that his art of making tattoos does not go awry. This ensures a clean work of body art and customer satisfaction.
