Third After you have enabled a decision to work for a few minutes to absorb as much liquid as you can using paper towels. Many people also vacuum dry, but I prefer that the area to air dry. The fourth Once the area is completely dry, baking powder, and a scattering of other additional way to get rid of the smell, especially in carpets.

You can erase or use a brush to work it in this area. A few minutes later, just vacuum the powder. Repetition of this procedure is sometimes necessary for older stains.
