1. Change the oil every 3,000 to 5,000 miles, and / or implement what is in your user guide.
2. Have a look at all of the automobile's fluids - Power steering fluid and transmission fluid, windshield washer solvent, brake system fluid, battery fluids, radiator antifreeze. Make sure you Don't check the fluids when the car is hot, except for the transmission fluid, that you take a look at while the car engine is operating. When refilling battery fluids make sure distilled water is utilised.
3. Make sure that the car's battery and cables are attached securely and without any deterioration. Make sure the posts on your vehicle battery are clean. In cases where there is any kind of battery corrosion, get a wire brush and clean it, or you can soak Coca Cola over the battery posts. Make certain that the distilled water is topped up to the interior full marks, never to the top of the battery.
4. Examine your car tires and tire pressure one or more times every month. Under-inflated vehicle tires will certainly decrease your fuel mileage and cost you money simply because results in premature tire wear. One of the fastest ways to wear out your tires would be to pay no attention to proper tire pressure
5. Rotating your tires is probably the best tire maintenance steps every car owner needs to do. The rule of thumb is to switch them about every 6000 miles, but this does depend on the vehicle model and your driving practices. Make sure that the tires are wearing uniformly to extend their life expectancy.
6. Check your windscreen wipers. Look for breaks and/or tears.
7. Be sure you have a very good spare tire, and also that it is in good working order.
8. Take a close look at your air filter. Change a soiled air filter. All of the dirt, dust and debris produce a undesirable effect on your engine's performance. This easy bit of maintenance can increase your fuel performance by about 10-15%.
9. Make it a point to read through your vehicles Owner Manual. It is there so you can get a better know-how about your automobile and its advised maintenance schedule.
10. Make sure that your vehicle is kept tuned up.
11. Check the gas cap. If there is a loose or missing fuel cap, this will let your fuel evaporate, even if you aren't driving around.
12. Lights Check. Both inside and out, your automobile's lighting is critical to keeping you free from danger. Regularly check your brake lights, headlights, and signal lights to ensure that they're doing the job so that your motor vehicle is visible, and also to see any other motor vehicles, pedestrians, or other potential obstacles on the road
