Once water has been removed, use dry cloths to wipe down any and all walls and surfaces in order to try and prevent the growth of mold. Make sure that the area is well ventilated. Allowing air to circulate freely will not only help to prevent mold, but will also help to prevent any sour odors.

If any debris has formed or if you have accumulated excess trash from one time use rags, be sure to get your hands on some industrial strength garbage bags. As you are removing debris, make sure that gloves, protective eyewear and protective clothing are worn in order to prevent injury or any other health risks.

The next thing that should be on the list to do, is to perform a thorough cleaning of the area using sanitizing cleansers. Again, it's important to maintain a well-ventilated area both during and after the cleaning process. After the area has been thoroughly cleaned, you'll have to give the area time to completely dry out. It is during this period that you should keep an eye out for areas in walls that feel soft to the touch or appear to have discoloration.
