Conduct checkups on your tap cutoffs at least twice every year. This can be done by opening and closing the cutoff taps and shutting off all the exterior taps during the winter seasons.

Remove sediments from your water heater by opening and cleaning it at least twice every year. This will help in saving money on both the water and energy billing.

Spray some oil around the taps of those toilet tanks that are not used frequently and especially those that are above the water level. This will help in preventing their blockage.

Insulate your piping system around the house to help protect your system from freezing temperatures during winter. Blow dryers and heat guns can also be used to unblock the pipes from the frozen water inside.

Pour some hot water in your kitchen sink frequently to melt any oil residues that could lead to the blockage of your drainage system as it solidifies.

What You Should Avoid During Home Plumbing

Avoid throwing things such as nylon papers or sanitary napkins into your toilets as this could lead to the blockage of your drainage system.

Avoid disposing tea leaves or other food remains such as rice into the sink as this will block your sink drainage system. Pour oily water away from the sink or make sure that you pour hot water into

the sink after washing the dishes.

Prevention of possible blockages is more important and could prevent costly plumbing work. It is important to therefore adhere to the dos aforementioned and avoid the donâ€™ts as well for better results.
