Buy drawers built in the bottoms of beds, chests of drawers with plenty of space, etc. if you want your children to put away their things nicely.

If you are looking to furnish a child's room where younger children will stay, it would be wise to see that the edges of the furniture are not too sharp or pointy, as children can hurt themselves against these. Most furniture-makers who design items for children do keep this in mind, so it should not be too difficult to get furniture with more rounded, soft edges.

Make sure you take your children along when you are buying furniture for their room. It is, after all, furniture that is to be used specifically by them, and not by you. An easy way to do this is to look for furniture for children online. You simply have to conduct an internet search for such furniture using your favourite search engine, and then, along with your children, you can browse through a number of catalogues that deal with children's beds, night-stands etc.
