These days, deck manufacturers also use artificial decking products such as mixed plastics and wood fibers—often called composite lumbers.

In Georgia, decks are more frequently exposed to the ravages of rain and heat. In most cases, damage is less severe, involving only general fading of the wood's color and a deterioration of texture. However, in some cases, the wood's integrity is damaged or compromised, as evidenced by the appearance of cracks or splits that can run deep into the wood's structure.

For deck refurbishing, deck cleaning is the best option. Most damage results from the film that leaves, mold, and mildew leave behind, and they are often difficult to remove through conventional means. Because of this, homeowners prefer products with chemicals specifically designed to remove such stains. This is one reason why products for deck cleaning Atlanta GA residents usually prefer are those that contain chlorine bleach as such products do a good job in getting rid of mildew and other detriments.

To further protect the integrity of the wood, homeowners opt for deck sealing to maximize deck cleaning benefits. In this process, a deck sealant is applied over the surface of the wood, which is eventually absorbed through the wood's pores. Since moisture damages wood by seeping through its pores, deck sealants act by making the pores impermeable, thereby prolonging the wood's life and durability.
