Staining is more common in untreated oak furniture. To retard staining, the furniture pieces, especially the untreated ones, must be wiped with high-grade teak oil. In the absence of teak oil, a suitable substitute would be Danish oil. It also helps to retain the natural appearance and finish of the timber. Oak furniture, just as any other wooden furniture, should not be exposed to high levels of h

umidity and extreme temperature changes.
