But, there is one more sort of ceramic tile obtainable, usually identified as vitrified or glass tile. Vitrified tiles are extremely similar to ceramic tiles, however are made with a little different components. The clay is combined with quartz and feldspar, before it is heated in the furnace. These additional elements liquefy, forming a glass building block inside the tile. This glass element makes the vitrified files extremely tough and opposing to any sort of assimilation.

Indoors, homeowners can make use of vitrified and ceramic tiles for the similar uses, for example floors and countertops. Outside, on the other hand, water turns out to be a very vital issue in chilly climates, as only a small amount of dampness can ice over in winter months and break the tile. Vitrified has an assimilation rate of 0.50 percent, which is nearly-frost proof making it good as outdoor tiles, at the same time as ceramic ranges from 7 to 3 percent, making it inappropriate for outdoor uses.

Ceramic tile costs vary greatly, conditional on custom work and dimension. Vitrified tiles cost a couple of rupees more per square foot, because of their additional qualities. It moreover requires a stronger tile adhesive than ceramic tiles, which can cost more in fixing.

Vitrified tiles, contrasting ceramic tiles, are hardly ever glazed. In its place, a dye is mixed in with the clay before it is fired up. This dye makes the clay a consistent color, so even if the tile is broken, the color will stay the same. Rather than being glazed, vitrified tiles are either polished or unpolished. Polished Vitrified tiles have a dazzling shine, while unpolished versions are rougher and boast a more natural look.
