If you purchase a packing kit for a bedroom, you will get general boxes of varying sizes, but you will also get specialty wardrobe and mirror boxes that are uniquely designed for those purposes.

You can purchase a packing kit or a moving kit from your moving company. You might be offered a discount on these kits if you purchase them at the time you sign your contract, which is probably the best price on supplies that you will find. If, however, you do not get a discount on these supplies, you might be able to find them cheaper at discount stores, but you will have to buy all of the supplies separately.
