These windows are energy-efficient and hard to break into, which is an important factor to consider when getting replacement windows. Another type of window preferred by US residents is the bay window, which allow light to stream in from different angles, though they have limited ventilation capabilities.

Whatever type of window you choose, there are several factors that you have to consider before installing them. Replacement windows Boston residents use, for example, should be checked for the following: airtightness, watertight-ness, wind load resistance, ease of operation, resistance to forced entry, condensation resistance, and screen strength. These things have to be taken into account to ensure that you wouldn't have to replace your windows again anytime soon.
