Birds will come to bath in your water features and other animals like squirrels and hedgehogs will come to drink from them. This is an ideal way to attract an ecosystem to your garden that is not only fascinating and fun to watch (particularly if you are an animal lover) but also that can help to maintain your garden. Attracting hedgehogs to your garden for instance is a great way to get rid of worms and slugs, and birds can help to do this too – allowing you to keep an organic garden that doesn't rely on pesticides.

And on top of all this your water features are great features in themselves. They will be fascinating and fun to watch, and particularly if you have children you'll find they love splashing in them and throwing coins in to make wishes.
