In such case, you can ensure your online privacy by following simple steps while surfing through the internet.

Do you know maintain privacy online is very simple if we get to know what to do and what not to do? The first factor that you need to consider about your online privacy is to know whether you have a "Secure Internet Connection". Remember, when you are at work, you are being monitored, and so avoid even having sensitive files on your computer and also prevent personal mailing.

List out the different "Sites offering rewards or prizes" just when you click on them and make sure that you don't get into them, as they do award you in exchange of your personal details. Your personal details are much more to these sites as they can sell it to anybody for a value more than the reward you got. Never reply to a spammer. Whatever may be the reason, avoid replying them irrespective of however good the offer is that they make. If you get to open the message, sometimes you get to forward it to everybody on your mailing list or sometimes your personal details are revealed to the spammer as a reply.

You got to be very conscious about the "Web Security" while browsing. In case you are banking or shopping online where you get to provide your credit card number, make sure you have the https:// before the web address and not the http:// in the URL. The https:// denotes that your transactions are secure and only you and the bank officials can access your credit card number. Now as a final step check your online privacy through the websites that check your online privacy level accurately and examine the privacy policies of your service provider. Not to mention, even if you have a secure

internet connection, your online privacy can be at risk, if you don't decide what information is to be revealed, to whom and when and how and what not to be revealed.
