Check the credibility of the site before considering the source in a site. By determining the domain of the website you can decide if it's a professional site or not. Look for the URL ending with .gov/.org/.mil/.museum/.aero/.edu. These domain names are a great indicator as to what kind of website you are dealing with but this alone is not enough to trust a site.

The next thing to do is to research about the author. Each website has an author that clearly indicates who has written the information. Check if the author has published anything else that pertains to your search, source of the published information and for author's credentials. Make sure if the site is copyrighted and constantly updated. Try and find the date of published data for its relevancy to the present day as it could be out of date. Published data must be error free and must connect to the information when browsed on other sites. If the information cannot be produced elsewhere it is most likely unbelievable.

You may also consider checking the popularity of the site by gauging the amount of traffic for the site using either Alexa.com or Compete.com. Both Alexa.com and Compete.com offer web traffic analysis to the top 1,000,000 web sites in the world. Also the whois-search (website.com/whois-search) will tell you the registered owner and more importantly it will tell you how long the website name has been registered, the server location and location details of the owner. You can also make use of other tools supported by Google like info:website.com tells you about the site, related:website.com lists similar sites and link:website.com lists all the links to the site you are interested in.
