Today due to sources, it is possible to create clever duplicates of the stone, which is why it is important to have an eye on whether they are genuine or not. Here are some ideas to get the right Turquoise Jewelry that is high quality and genuine.

Tips and advice â€“

1. Usually Turquoise Jewelry is manufactured China, Iran, USA, Australia, etc. If the stone comes from these places then you can be pretty sure that it is genuine. They arenâ€™t mined and produced everywhere, therefore you can be pretty sure that the dealer knows a lot about the stone, and chances are they are genuine.
2. The certificate of genuine and true stones is also a good idea to have when you finally purchase the stones. Ensure that you have this, so that you know you arenâ€™t being cheated.
3. Often Turquoise is treated by pouring wax, chemicals, etc on them. If you have some beads with the same stone then try to check inside of the beads too, if they are white in color underneath, then they might be false. The color should go all around and inside the beads too.
4. The stone is priced evenly, it is neither too cheap nor too expensive, and if you have a very cheap deal on Turquoise Jewelry then chances are the stone isnâ€™t turquoise at all.
5. Remember that the color on the stone isnâ€™t even at all, often there are grey or black veins all across the stone and there is difference in the pigmentation as well. So this is another technique to find out whether the stone is genuine or not.
