To reside in harmoniously inside a home is every person's right. Because of this, Ontario government does not accept any form of domestic assault. If you had been physically, emotionally, financially or sexually abused by any relative, you have the right to take legal action against the one accountable. However, you cannot merely concerns in your own hands; you must do it only based on what the Ontario law allows. In the end, nobody is above the law.

Before making any pursuit, it is best to seek advice from an attorney. Ontario has a lot of organizations that offer free legal advice to those who need it. Nevertheless, you shouldn't hire just any professional; look for a lawyer that you can depend on. You must obtain a lawyer that's ready to guard your rights and assist you in getting justice which you deserve, not someone who is only after his pockets. Apart from getting help from a professional, you also have to understand these terms.

Restraining order. If the accused has inclinations to hurt you and your children, you can ask a restraining order, with the help of your lawyer, from the court so you can be guarded. However, it's also wise to know that you can still ask a restraining order as long as you are married with the accused, although you don't have any kids. The stipulations that will be set by the court ought to be properly followed by the accused otherwise he can be arrested.

Possession of home. It's also possible to report a request to reside in your house without the presence of accused. The judge may also consider finding other areas in which you and your children can reside conveniently. There are a number of things that needs to be considered until the request can be granted. You must seek advice from an Ontario family law expert to know more information about possession of home.

Separation. Domestic assault is a significant offense and can serve as a reason for divorce or separation. If you are thinking about filing for separation, talk to your trusted Ottawa family lawyers first to assist you to plan if you are seeking action.

Although you may ask not to go through case, it's still up to the crown prosecution whether to carry on or otherwise. Talk to your Ottawa lawyers regarding this; they may help you find solutions to persuade the crown to end the complaint.
