A confirmed mesothelioma diagnosis is something that will terrify the bravest person. This disease is a deadly cancer that originates from the thin membrane that covers many internal organs. The most commonly affected area is the chest and abdominal cavity, both of which have a poor prognosis. The most tragic part of this disease is that it is usually detected in advanced stages with little hope of recovery. The only cause of this insidious disease is asbestos exposure.

Patients are often at crossroads when they are diagnosed with mesothelioma. There is no clear answer of whom to blame. Mesothelioma cases are at times quite difficult. Manufacturers were aware of the hazardous and carcinogenic properties of asbestos, yet continued to use it or others would not own up to using it in buildings. Beside medical help, victims of this disease should seek counsel from a mesothelioma lawyer who can help them seek compensation from whoever is responsible for their pain and suffering.

It is extremely important to find an experienced and devoted mesothelioma lawyer. This illness is unlike any other cancer and asbestos litigation is not a run of the mill compensation lawsuit. First, there is a large amount of documentation required to be filed with the court that has jurisdiction to hear the case. However, the biggest challenges for a mesothelioma lawyer are often in establishing that the plaintiff is suffering due to wrongful or negligent asbestos exposure and then identify the person or entity (usually a manufacturer) responsible for it. This is easier said than done.

Just to give an example, it is not necessary for courts in the state a patient lives in to hear the case. Moreover, several states have different laws governing asbestos litigation and one can easily lose rights to file a claim. For example, there are strict and varying deadlines after a patient becomes aware of an asbestos related disease. If the lawsuit is filed in New York, it must be filed within three years of first diagnosis. However, if it is in New Jersey or Pennsylvania, it must be filed within two years. This means that individuals having health problems due to asbestos exposure should seek medical aid and consult a mesothelioma lawyer as soon as possible, because time for filing a claim may be limited.
