This process first originated as a business in 1956, when the International Organization for Standardization set rules for such transport in containers. The ships which transport these goods in large truck-size inter modal containers are also known as Container Ships and are specifically designed to withstand the shipment, handling and storage that this process of Containerization may require. However Container shipping, can also take place using trains and trailers designed to meet the same purpose. Whatever be the mode of transport, in this system, the goods are usually fitted into containers that are either 20 foot (6.09 meters), 40 foot (12.18 meters), 45 foot (14.6 meters) or 53 foot (16.15 meters) long, and might be open ended, open sided, open topped, half height, flat racked, refrigerated, liquid built (tank), modular or even for standard dry cargo. All these different kinds of cargo are each used for a specific kind of load, like for instance, the open topped containers are ideal for logs, machinery and other odd sized goods, similarly flat racks are used for carrying boats, vehicles, industrial equipment and machinery, therefore before transporting the items, it is necessary to select the right container so that the goods are not damages under any condition.

But while selecting the container, another important component that must be kept in the mind is the container shipping rates. The customers need to be very careful in this case, not just to find the lowest rates but also to find a service provider that has a reputation for successful shipping. To find the best container shipping service provider, the customers might want to check online, as the internet provides a wide list of companies engaged in such services along with the rates offered by them.
