It's no secret that dogs love the great outdoors. They love jumping in muddy puddles, playing tag with other dogs, and generally being sweet, happy and lovable companions. Fleas and ticks are the most common, but there's also the threat of biting flies, chewing lice and mosquitoes – any of which can carry disease. So what's a pet parent to do? Doing the Job of Four Medications at Once
