Even if you're going to use some off-the-shelf equipment, a trained professional can set things up in a way that will give your recreation area a character of its own.

If you're planning to set up a commercial outdoor playground, it's always a good idea to seek out the thoughts, opinions and ideas of the little ones who are going to use the space. However, while their input is good, they should not be entrusted to design the space themselves, lest you end up with difficulties that a professional designer could foresee and prevent from coming about. While kids can be very creative, a trained designer can interpret their ideas and transform them into a workable plan. Your playground will turn out to be better functioning and more fun for the kids.

If you're building playgrounds for preschools, then it's good to remember that play spaces need room for kids to run and climb, but under conditions where it's safe to do so. It's probably impossible to make any playground 100 percent safe, and a limited amount of risk can be acceptable, but any recreation area that is adequately supervised should have almost no problems with kids getting hurt, outside of an occasional scuffed knee. A too-safe playground might hold kids back from the learning experiences that they need to mature into adults.

Playgrounds are a wonderful place for kids to meet others, interact with their peers, and indulge in the fantasy play that makes childhood such a rewarding time of life.
