The examination comprises of: two x 2 hour written papers and a practical assessment, both of two 2-hour written exams includes "one long question― and "ten short questions― covering both the and NCC1. All questions are compulsory to attempt. The practical assessment comprises of carrying out a risk assessment of a workplace and compiling short report to management.
