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If you are looking for methods to generate a strong type custom configuration based on an XML Schema file, there are tools available to achieve this. The XML Schema Definition or the XSD Editor is an easy to use and effective tool which can be used to generate a custom configuration by adding some features that necessary to meet the configuration requirements.

It is easy to create a XML Schema file XSD if you don't have one. The XMLFox editor can be use to create one easily. In case you already have a XML file, you can still use the XMLFox editor to edit it before making any attempt to generate the configuration class.

It is even possible to generate XML Schema file from your existing XML file. All you have to do is open XML file from Vista Studio and select the XML menu and then create Schema. The nest step involves including the XML Schema file to your project. This involves setting up the VS project to generate configuration class automatically from the XML Schema File.

It now becomes possible to add the configuration class automatically generated to your project. The next procedure is creating the XML configuration file. One important thing to note here is that the XML configuration file has to be under the debug folder, the same one as the executable application. If you don't have the XML configuration file, don't fret. You can use the XML Schema explorer from VS to generate a sample XML file from your XML Schema file to get started.

Open Schema file and right click a node to choose the option for generating sample XML file. It is possible to set your schema file to be your XML file's schema set. This provides the validation and the intellisense ability in the XML editor.

Problems associated with the working of the XSD Schema standard can be easily dealt with by the use of graphical editing tools. The XML Schema is a graphical editor that offers many advantages which allows you to view the structure of the document graphically. You can edit the document with validation support, entry helpers and a few other useful editing features.

The XSD Schema editor tools can help editors deal with the common problems associated with describing data. It helps simplify presentation of complex data and various other tasks associated with data control and presentation. You can use XSD Schema Editor Software for free to create, format, map, view and edit an XML/XSD output.
