The city of Johannesburg situated in South Africa is one of the richest cities of the world. Though not the capital city of the country it is the economic and commercial hub of the country. But earlier the city had less significance in the tourism sector and lagged behind other cities. Johannesburg and its surrounding places have developed the places rich in flora and fauna to sanctuaries and zoos. The most popular among them are the Lion Park, The Roodeplaat, Suikerbosrand Nature Reserve, National Zoo of South Africa etc. Many adventure seekers and nature lovers all alike visit these destinations to enjoy a memorable holiday experience. The wildlife parks and zoos have diversified into conservation of endangered species of animals and birds attracting many customers of cheap flights to Johannesburg.

The Lion Park specializes in the conservation of lions which also includes rare species of white lions. Situated in the Gauteng province close to the cities of Johannesburg and Pretoria it is spread across five hundred acres of land. In addition to 80 lions the park consists other species of herbivores like antelope, blesbok, gnu, impala, gemsbok, zebra and carnivorous animals like cheetah and wild dog. The park also has diverse tourist attractions such as picnic areas, barbecue sites, a swimming pool and a restaurant.

The Roodeplaat area situated near Pretoria is a name shared by a wildlife reserve and a dam. The wildlife century is home to 250 species of birds and animals like zebra, warthog, wildebeest; impala etc. Bird watchers and animal lovers throng this destination using direct flights to Johannesburg. The dam offers adventure activities like fishing, camping and hiking etc. On the other hand rare species of animals like porcupine, aardvark, springbok, zebra and hyena can be found in The Suikerbosrand Nature Reserve. It is situated very close to the Johannesburg International Airport.

The National Zoological Gardens of South Africa situated in Pretoria is also known as the National Zoo of South Africa. Established in the year 1899 the zoo works for the conservation of endangered species like The White Rhino and Arabian Oryx. It also has an aquarium, a Reptile Park, primate, carnivore sections etc to attract many tourists.
