One of the world's largest conservatories, it houses a collection of exotic and rare species such as carnivorous plants and the corpse flower. San Francisco Flower Market

A popular source of gorgeous flowers San Francisco hotels Union Square decorators use for their arrangements is the San Francisco Flower Market located at 6th Street and Brannan.
