Australian work visa is that kind of visa that allows its holders to work in Australia and take the work opportunity of the country and contribute to the economy. Generally, we all are aware of the fact that visa is required for entering to foreign countries and Australia is not an exception in this connection. There are different types of Australian work visas that help talented and skilled workers to get thier desired jobs.

When it comes to working visas Australia, there are different categories related to it. It is very important to know all about Australian work visas as this helps in making the right decision when it comes to applying visa. Compared to other types of Australian visa this visa is a bit different as it allows the holder to stay in country for longer span and take the work opportunities available in the country.

Here the different categories and programs of Australian work visa have been briefly discussed that will help you to know more.

Australian Skilled Independent Visa: This is a kind of Australian work visa which is a permanent work visa for those persons who have all the required skills and qualifications to fill the skill shortage of Australia. The applicants of this visa are needed to obtain minimum of 65 points on point assessment. The basic eligibilities include the applicant must be below 50 years and they must be qualified or have skills mentioned on Skilled Occupation List.

Australian Skilled Sponsored Visa: This visa is also quite similar to the above mentioned type of visa but the only difference is that the applicant must obtain a sponsorship from an eligible relative residing in Australia or obtain nomination from a participating territory government or state.

Australian Skilled Regional Sponsored Visa: This Australian work visa is for those persons who have the required skilled and qualifications but failed to meet the pass mark needed to acquire skilled independent visa. Applicants of this visa must be well-prepared to live for two years and work for a minimum of 12 months. This visa remains valid for three years and offers a path to permanent residence in Australia.

Temporary Business Long Stay Visa: Temporary business long stay visa or Australian 457 visa allows an employer to sponsor its overseas workers in order to fill in the nominated skilled positions. The applicant of this visa must have an employer willing to sponsor the person as a part of visa application process. On the other hand employers must meet the specific nomination and sponsorship steps before the prospective employee can apply for this visa. This working visa Australia is valid for four years.

Australian Working Holiday Visa: The Australian working holiday visa offers working opportunities for individuals between 18 and 30 years to work in the country's primary sector while holidaying in Australia. Holders of this work holiday visa can opt for short term or casual employment to meet their travel cost. The applicant must hold passport from countries that have reciprocal working holiday program with Australia. Applicants are also required to meet financial, character and health requirements.
