Bo-Kaap Museum: Built in the 18th century, this museum was originally the home of Abu Bakr Effendi, a well-known Turkish scholar. Brought in the mid-19th century to help quell feuding between Muslim factions and to have written one of the first books in Afrikaans, the museuem is worth visiting boarding Cape Town Flights. The house has been furnished to re-create the lifestyle of a typical Malay family in the 19th century.

Two Oceans Aquarium: This aquarium is considered one of the finest in the world. Stunning displays reveal the marine life of the warm Indian Ocean and the icy Atlantic. Explore the vast, kelp forest or the predator tank, where you can swim with large ragged-tooth sharks or get a legal adrenaline rush. Look for the endangered African penguins, also known as jackass penguins because of the awkward braying noise they make; pulsating moon jellies and spider crabs; and frog exhibits while booking Flights to Cape Town.

World of Birds: Walk through aviaries housing 450 species of indigenous and exotic birds, including eagles, vultures, penguins, and flamingos. Cages are not present and birds fly freely here; however, the big raptors are kept behind fences.

Gold of Africa Museum: This museum chronicles the history and artistry of African gold and houses one of the best collections in the world. The exquisite exhibition cleverly displayed in a darkened room, leaves you gasping. Artisans from Mali, Senegal, Ghana, and the Ivory Coast certainly knew how to transform this precious metal. Witness the workshop where you can watch jewelers busy at their craft. When you've taken in all the opulence you can, visit the excellent gift shop where you can buy replicas of some traditional Ghanaian jewelry designs while flying with Cheap Flights to Cape Town.
